

**PREBLE TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLUTIONS  
FOR  
GOPHER BOUNTY**

The Board of Supervisors of Preble Township, Fillmore County, hereby adopts the following resolutions:

WHEREAS, property owners and farmers in Preble Township continue to complain about the abundance of pocket gophers that damage land and crops with tunneling and mounds.

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes § 348.12 authorizes the Preble Township Board of Supervisors to offer a bounty for the destruction of pocket gophers located within this township.

RESOLVED, the Preble Township Board of Supervisors hereby approves and adopts this resolution to offer a bounty, during calendar year 2015, for the destruction of pocket gophers located within Preble Township.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Preble Township will pay a bounty in the amount of \$2.00 for each pocket gopher killed within Preble Township.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that any resident of the township claiming a gopher bounty shall present to the Board of Supervisors (i) two front feet from each gopher for which a bounty is being claimed, and (ii) proof that such gopher was killed within Preble Township. Only township residents may claim the gopher bounty. Residency by the claimant is sufficient proof that such gopher was killed within Preble Township.
